

Good Goods Guidelines for Artist Submissions

Good Goods prefers to receive submissions from artists between **October 1st and February 28th**. Due to our busy summer season this allows us the most time to carefully consider each submission and still be able to schedule artists for the following summer.

In addition to your images, please include a written statement (1 page maximum) describing yourself and your work. Tell us about yourself! In order to understand your artwork we need to get to know you. Also, be sure to let us know why your work would be a good fit for Good Goods. Please tell us where your work has been represented before, including the internet.

Image guidelines:

A minimum of 5 images is necessary for us to adequately review your work. Feel free to include up to 10 images. You must label your images with the following: artist's name, size, media, and suggested retail price.

It is most convenient for us to review your images if you send them in one of the following formats:

1. JPEG format digital files. Images should be sized no larger than 1600px wide and be at least 200dpi. Digital files may be sent via e-mail, or on a CD.
2. Color photographs.

We cannot accept digital images in the following formats: Powerpoint presentations, web URLs, or digital files other than JPEGs.

Please do not send slides or your original artwork.

Please make sure all submission materials are clearly labeled with your name, phone number, and email address. Include an addressed and postage paid envelope if you would like your CD or photographs returned to you. **Please include your first and last name and "artist submission" on the subject line of email submissions.**
